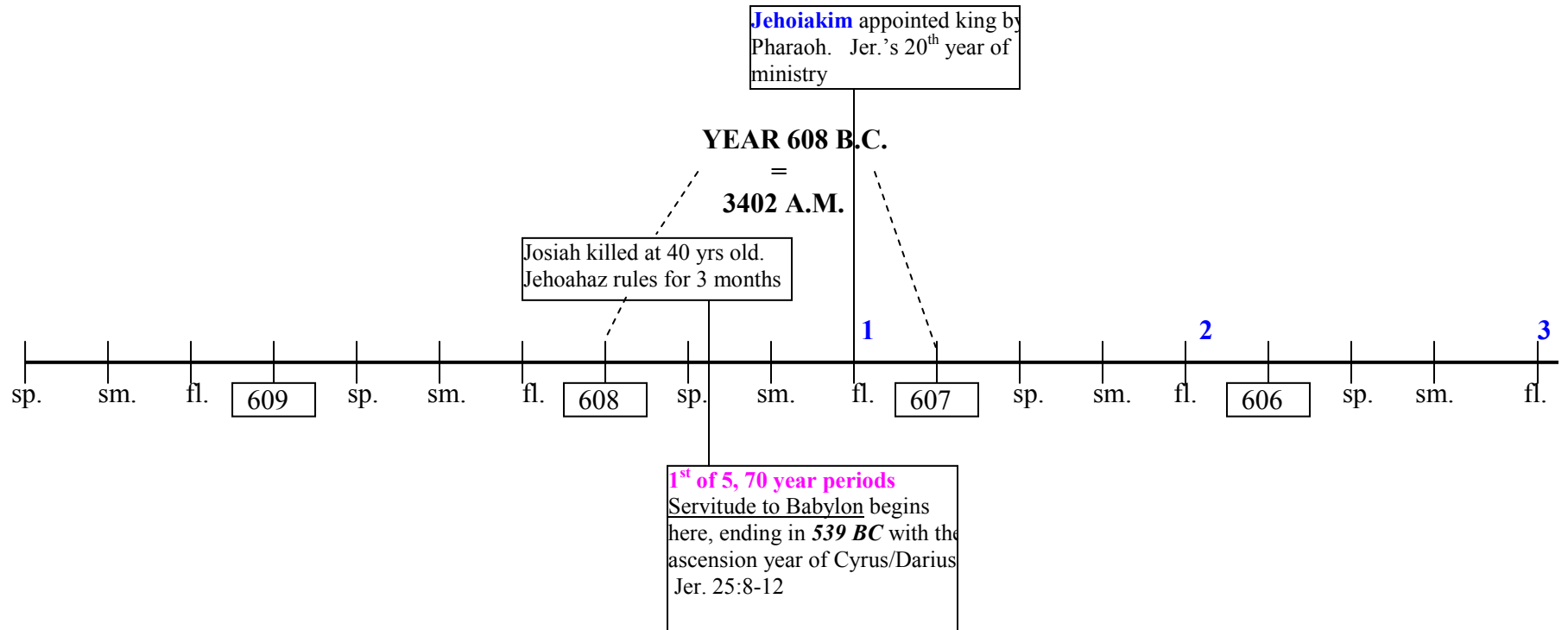


4010 – AM date = BC date



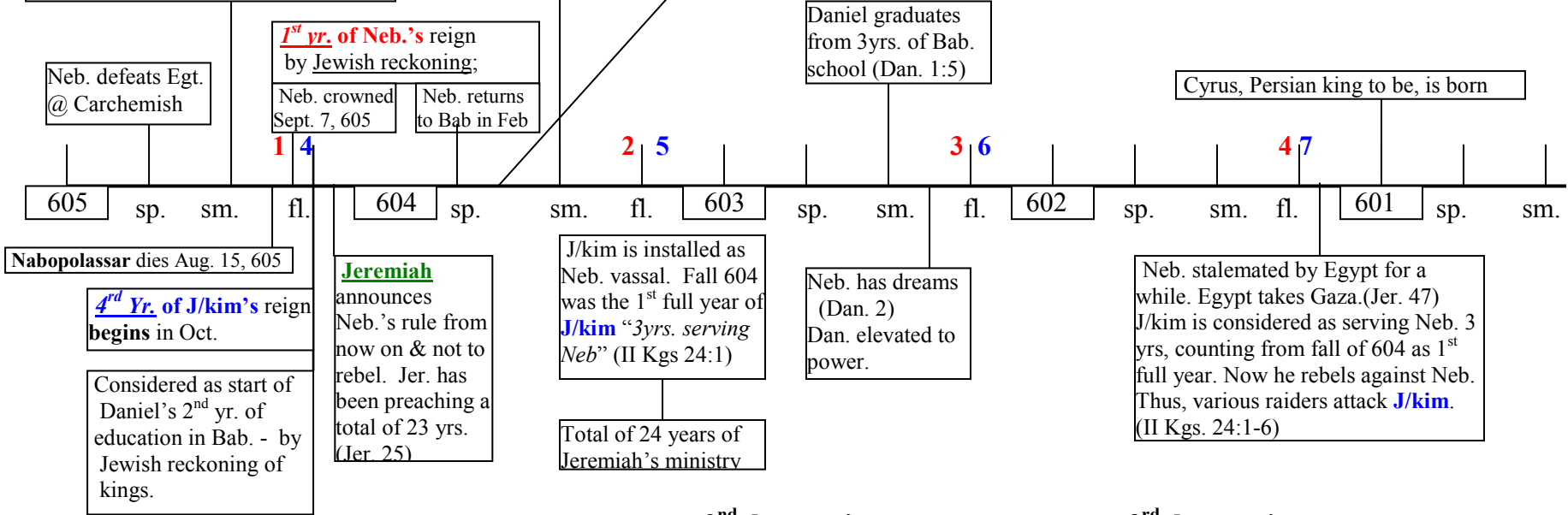
1st deportation

Prince Neb. sacks Jerus. Takes J/kim to Bab. in 3rd yr of J/kim reign
Daniel deported (Ezekiel 17 yrs old)
 (II Chr.36:6/Dan.1:1)
 2nd 70 year period: **Daniel's ministry**
 Dan.1:21,(see 535 BC)

Jer. 46 – “4th yr. of J/kim” is date of letter mocking Egypt’s past defeat at Carchemish

April 2, 604 Neb shook hands with gods’ Bel & Bel’s son. Babylonians counted regal years from spring to spring, not fall to fall like the Jews

Red – Nebuchadnezzar’s reign
Blue – Jehoiakim’s reign
Brown – Jehoiachin’s captivity
Purple – Zedekiah’s reign



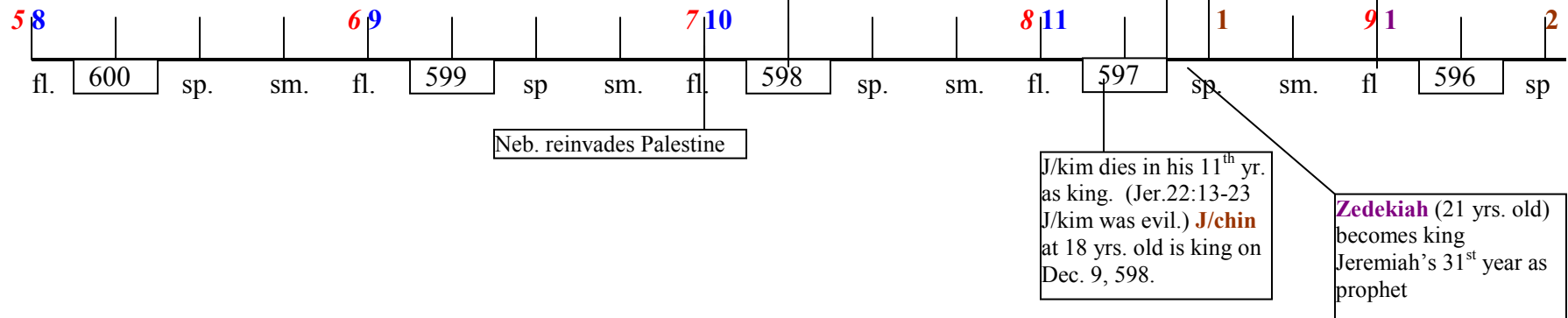
2nd deportation

Neb. returns to Jerus. and captives **3,023** Jews (Jer. 52:28)
 Rechabites move to countryside (Jer. 35)

3rd deportation

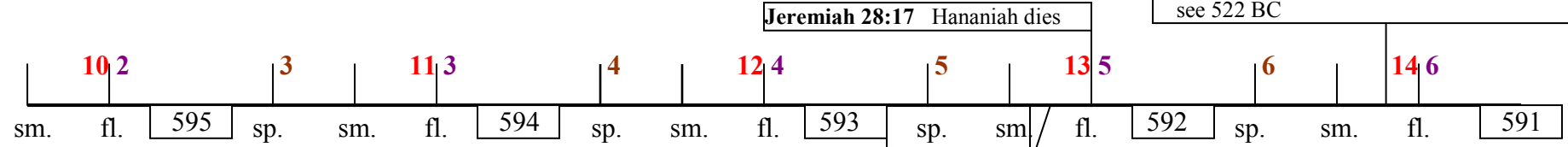
Neb. captures **J/chin** and **10,000** others. (II Kg 24:14)
Ezekiel and **Mordecai** are also taken captive (Es.2:6)

Zedekiah regal yr. count begins in solar year for Jews.



Nebuchadnezzar's 7 year insanity according to Jordan ??? Dan. 4

Ez. 8:1 in 6th yr, 6th mn, 5th dy, (toward end of the 430 days) Ezekiel's **2nd vision**. He has a vision of all the abominations in temple, with elders sitting b/f him at his exile-house. (**ch.8 - ch.11**) On 6th mn. last day, 430 days ended for Ezekiel. 592 B.C.
3rd 70 yr. period: desolation of temple, see 522 BC



Jeremiah 28:17 Hananiah dies

Jeremiah 51:59 the prophet sends word of Babylon's destruction

Jeremiah 27-28 (4th yr, 5th mn. of Zed.) Jerem. confronts the false prophet Hananiah.

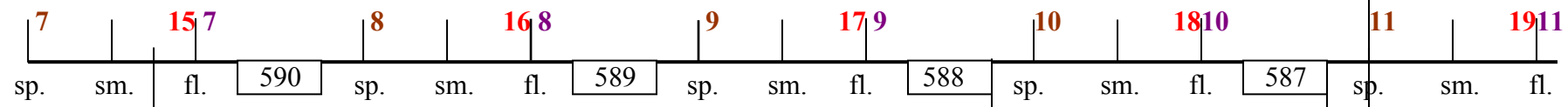
Ez. has 1st vision at 30 yrs. old (593BC), a message from God, the temple is abandoned by God in 592. 5th yr of **J/chin** captivity; 4th mn, 5th dy. (**Ez.1:1**)

Then for **7 days** he sat with exiles. Fulfilled his consecration as a priest. (**Ez. 3:7,8 & Lev. 8:35**)

Then for **430 days**, Ez. prophesied against a clay model of Jerusalem, for each year of evil. Ezekiel's judgments started at 1023 BC (430 yrs earlier) with David's sinful census and sacrifice at the **temple's location**. David was approx. 68 yrs. old then, in 38th yr of his 40th reign. (II Sam. 24:18-25 & **Ez. 4: 1-6**)

Ez. 30:20-26 11th yr, 1st mn, 7th dy. Prophecy against **Egypt**

Ez. 31:1 11th yr., 3rd mn., 1st dy. Prophecy against **Egypt**



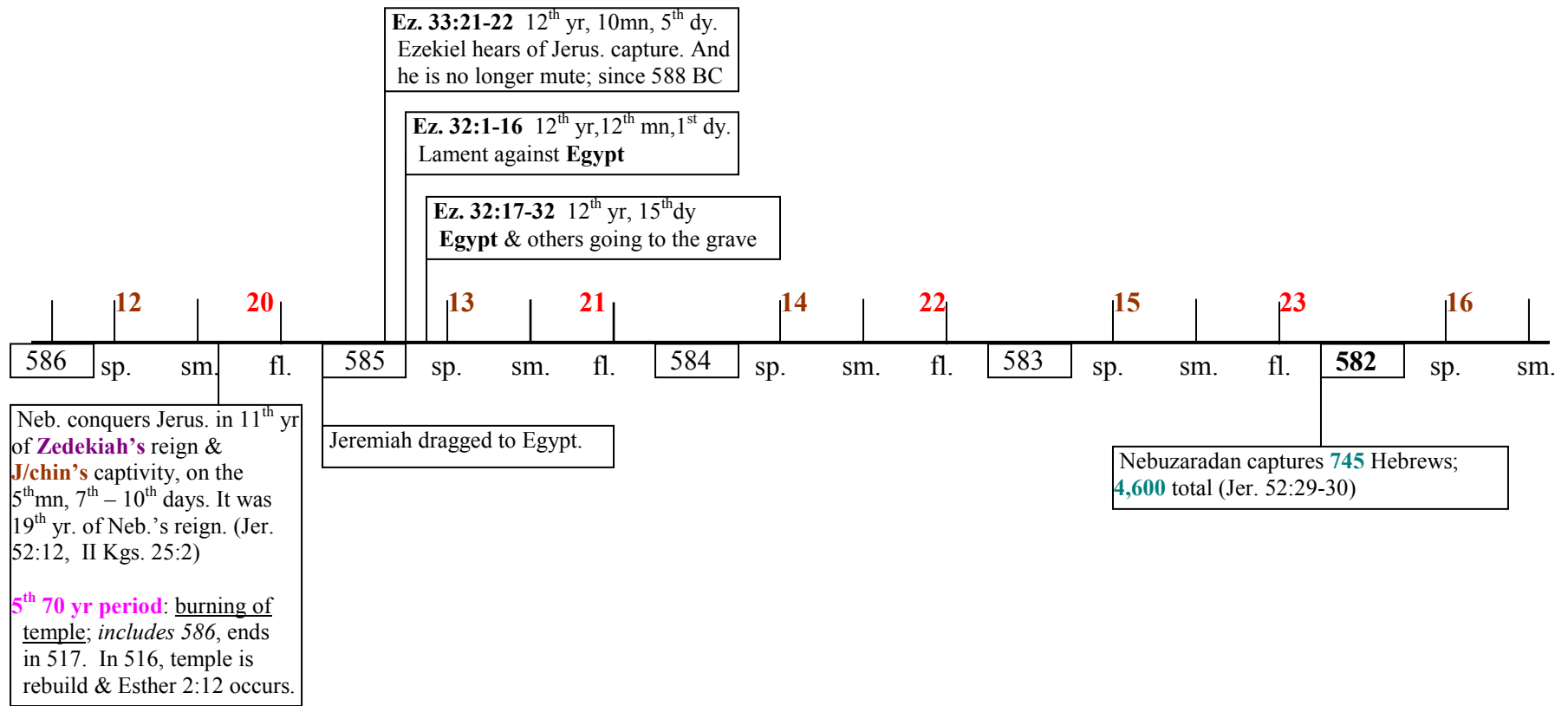
Ez. 20:1 in 7th yr, 5th mn. 10th dy; Ezekiel's message to exiles.

Ez. 24:1 in 9th yr, 10th mn, 10th dy, Neb. lays siege to Jerus. that "very day" in 588BC. Siege lasts 2 yrs. (See also II Kgs.25:1; Jer.52:4) Ezekiel's wife also dies. (Ez.24:16) He becomes mute. (Ez. 24:1,27) 40 yrs. after Josiah purged land (628) 40 yr. of Jeremiah prophetic ministry
4th 70yr period: wrath on city/siege, includes 588, ends in 519 B.C. (Zech.1:12)

Ez. 26:1- ch.28 11th yr, 1st day of mth. Prophecy against Tyre / High Priest

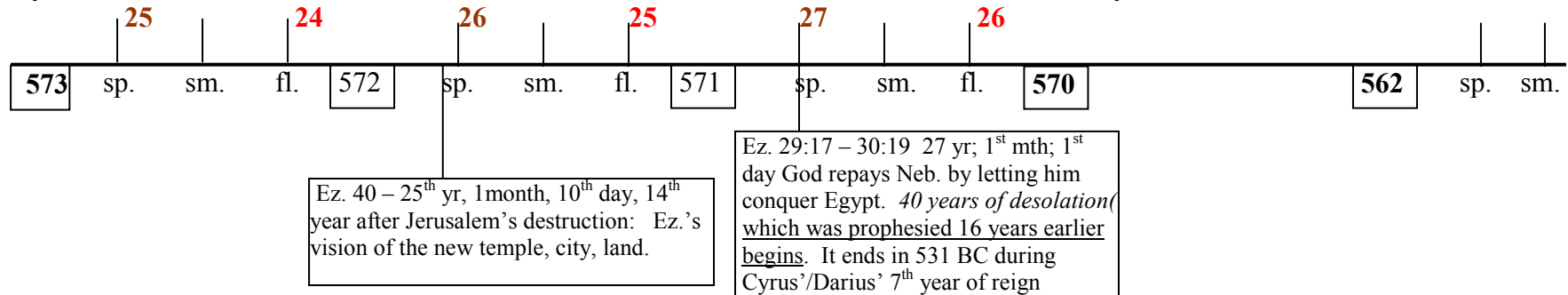
Ez. 29:1-16 10th yr., 10th mn, 12 dy Prophecy against **Egypt**. 40 years desolation predicted. Begins in 571 ends in 531

Neb. captures **832** from Jerus. (Jer. 52:29)

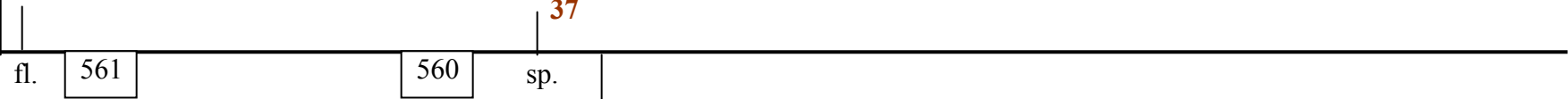


9 yrs. later: 582-573
